

## 2016-2026 Ohio Employment Projections

# Technology Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2017, the technology industry cluster's average annual pay was **\$84,922<sup>1</sup>**. During this same time period, Ohio's statewide private industry average annual wage was \$48,577.
- The technology industry is expected to provide **6,977** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
